one manilla folder.

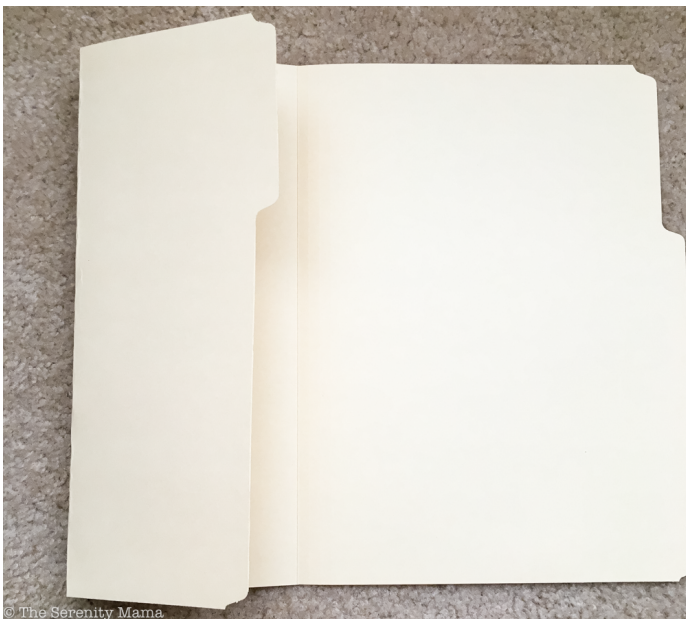

Open it

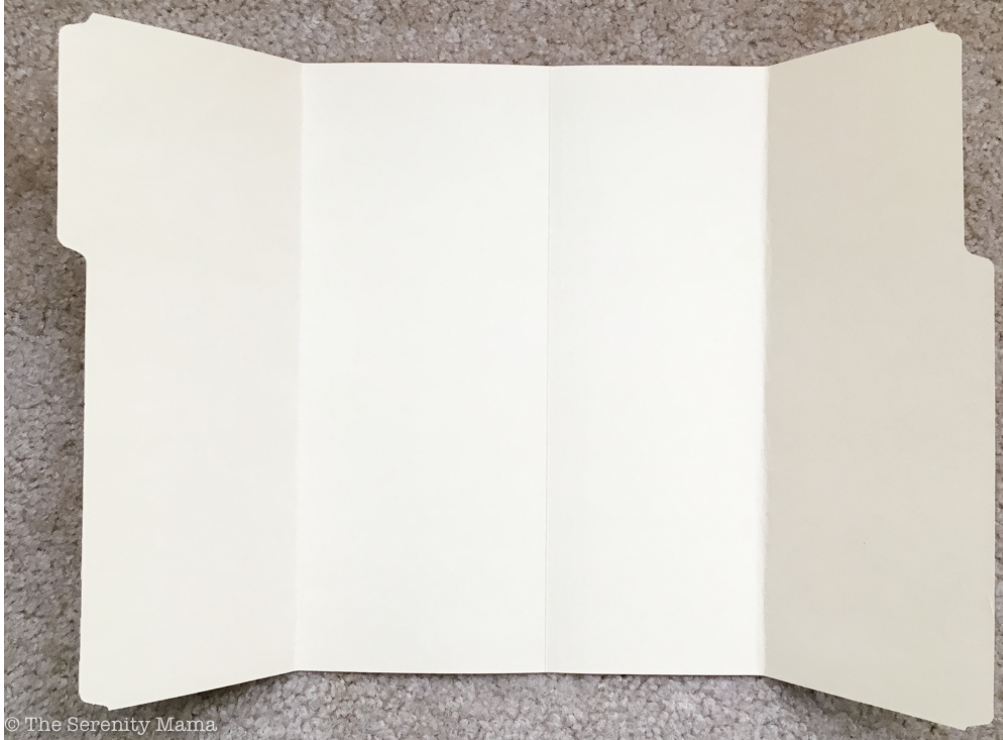


Fold one

crease



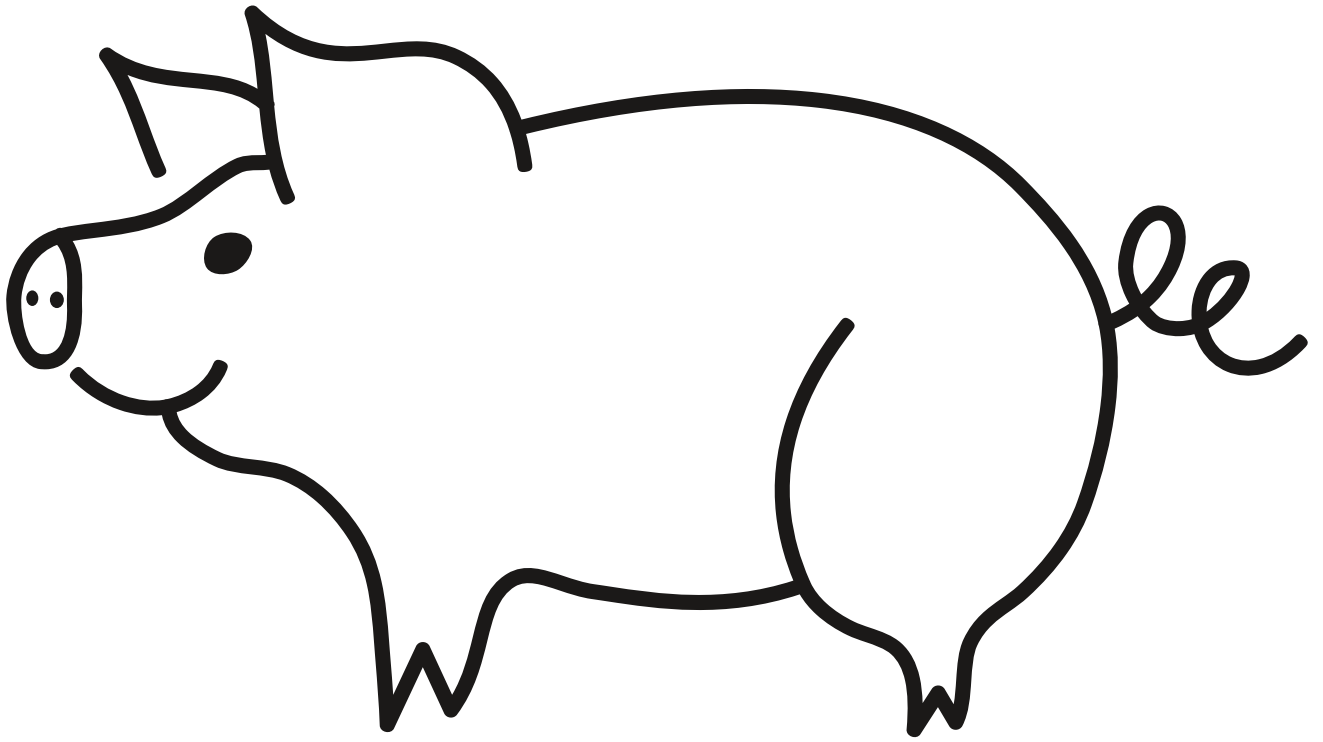
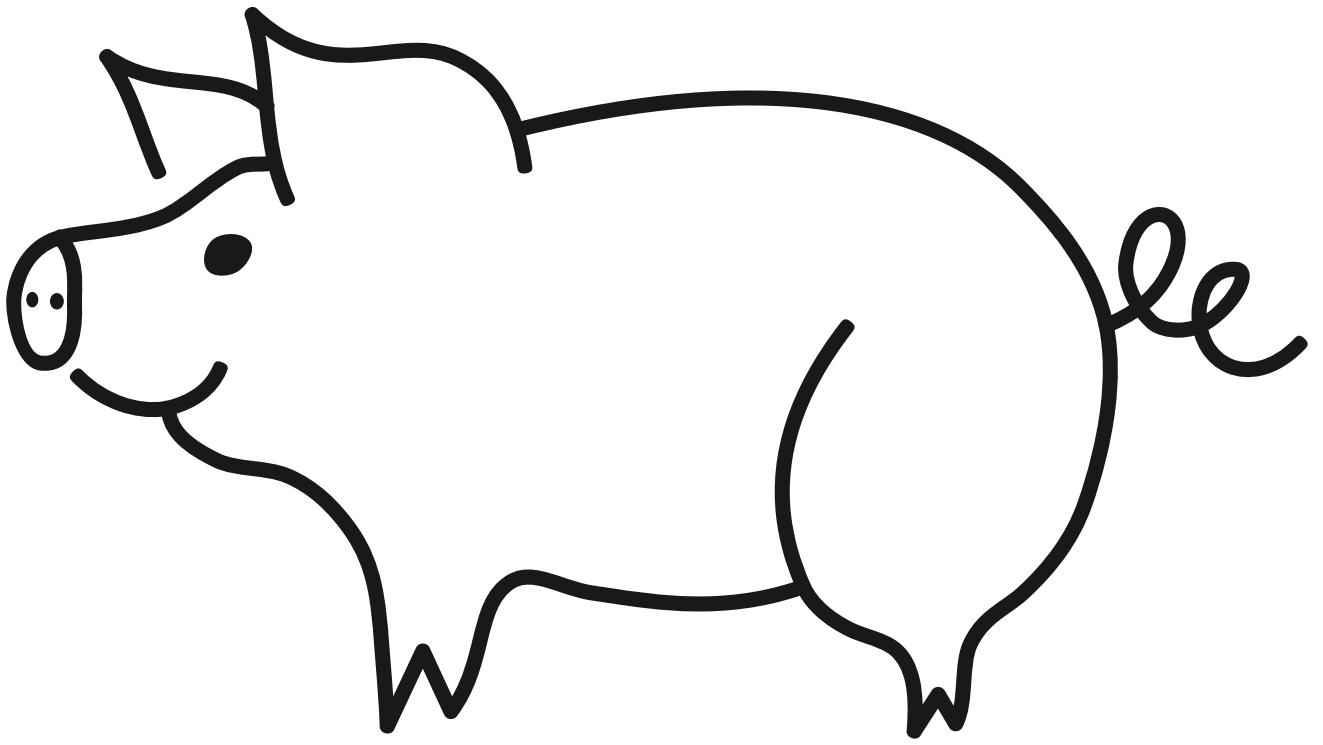
