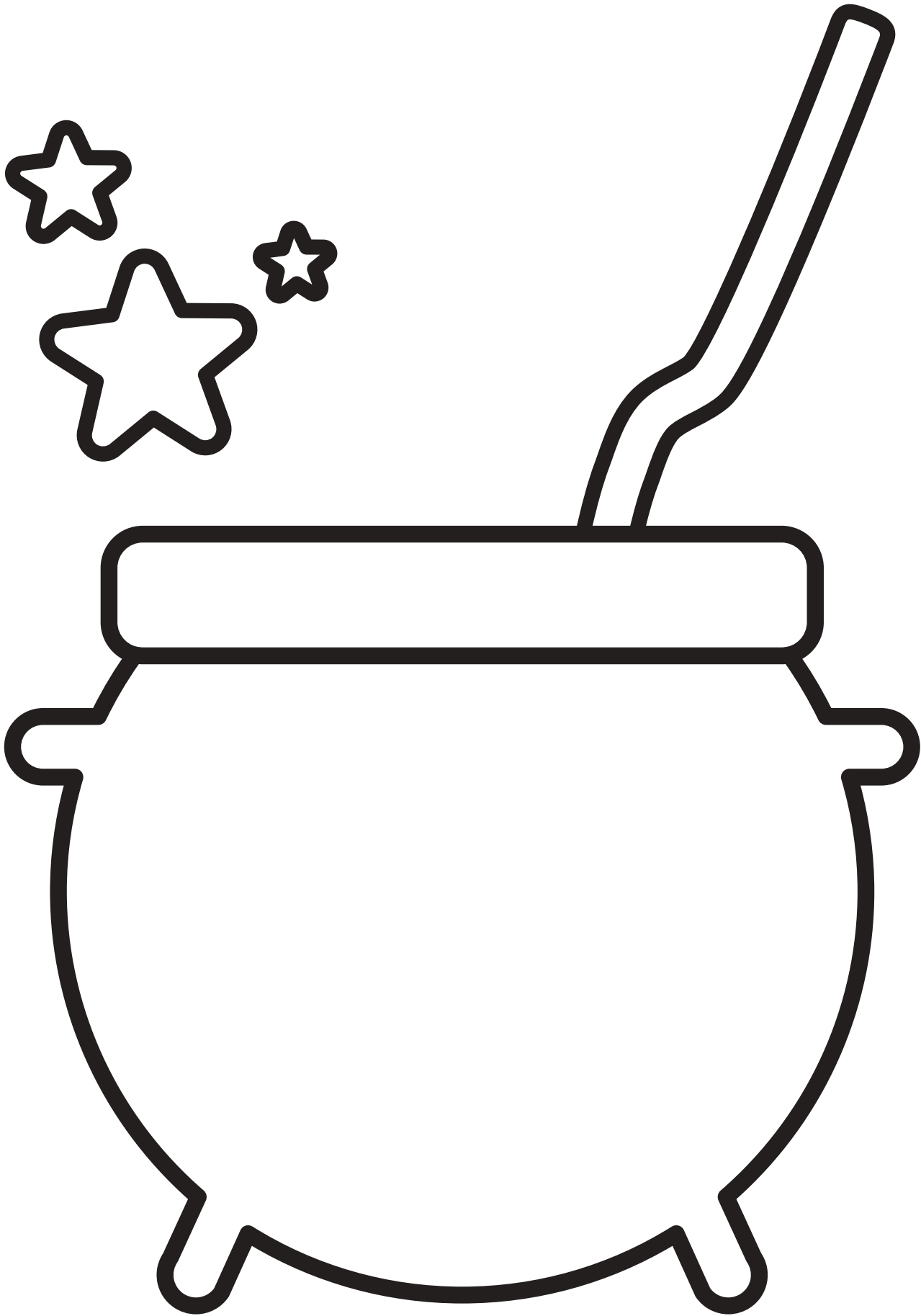

2 pipe cleaners

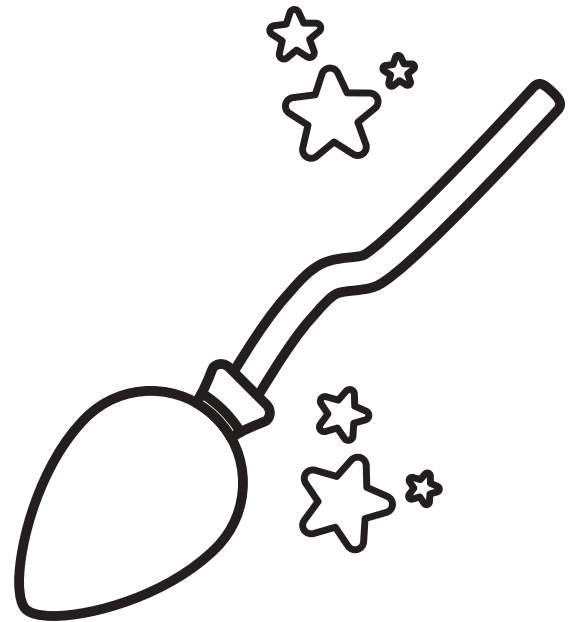
Glue

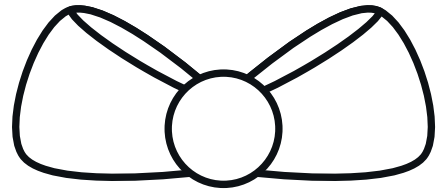
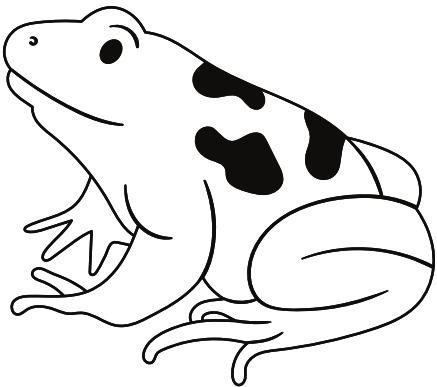
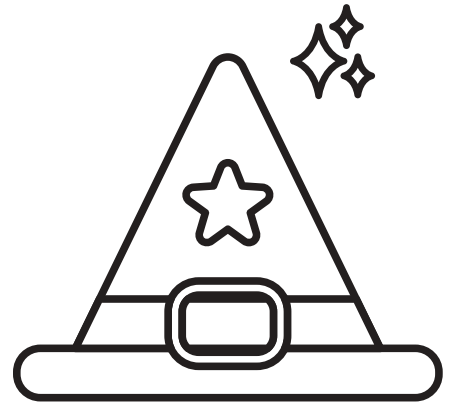
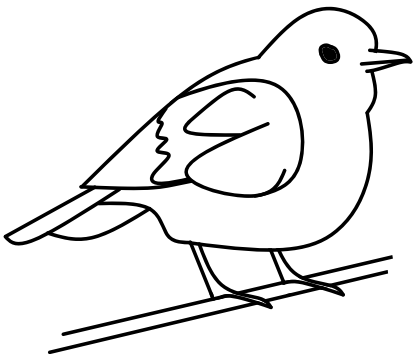
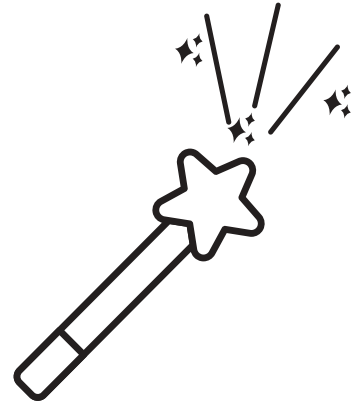
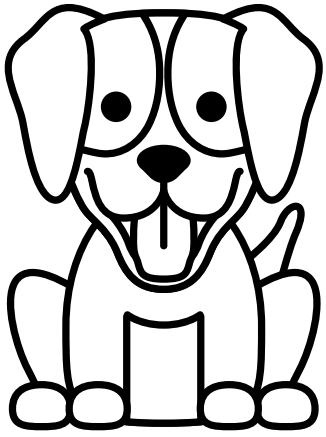
TO DO:

order as told in the story.

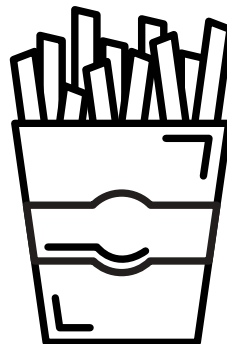
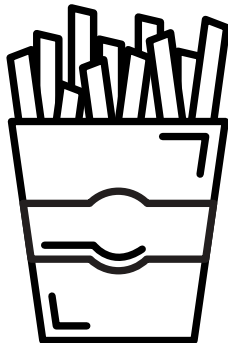
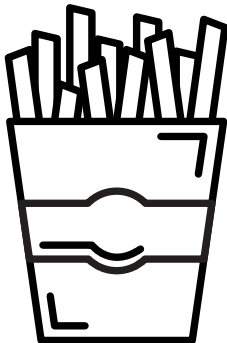
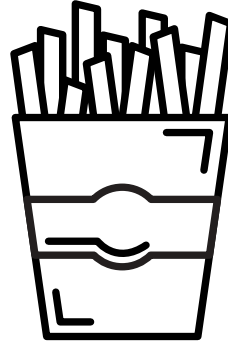
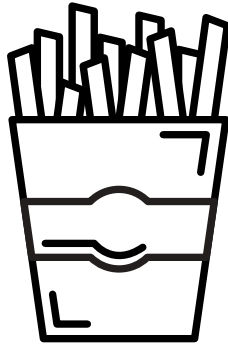
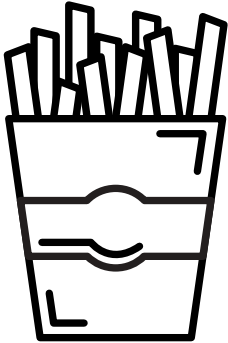
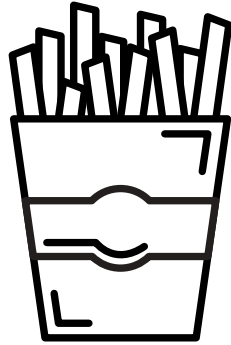
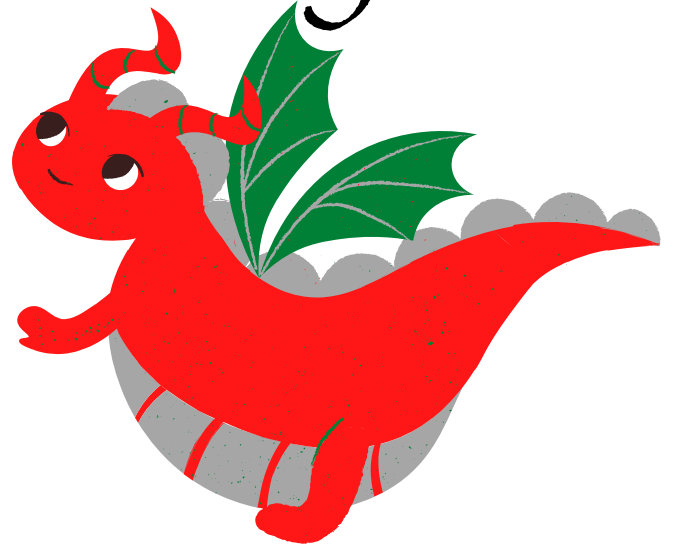


Draw a line to connect the animal to the item they helped the witch find.
